



### **Summer School: Goffs Academy**

Goffs ran a 5 day summer school for Year 6 into 7 students, and a 5 day summer school for Year 10 into 11 students, with a total number of 293 students attending. The summer school programme included a blend of academic education and enrichment activities

#### **Aim of the summer school:**

- Enable students to feel part of a community with their fellow students
- Enable students to forge relationships with new teachers
- Enable students to familiarise themselves with their new school environment
- Ensure (new Year 11) students were able to consolidate key learning, ahead of the autumn term

<b><u>Team Building</u></b> Team building activity to support students in meeting new students and developing social skills	£1756
<b><u>Outdoor Enrichment</u></b> Outdoor multi activities session to support students in building social skills and working as a team	£3330
<b><u>Enrichment Activities</u></b> In school activities to ensure students have an opportunity to meet key staff, familiarise themselves with the school building and build relationships with their peers	£2000
<b><u>Educational Sessions (Yr6 into 7):</u></b> Introduction to English, Food, Science, PE, IT, Maths, Music and PE. Students had the opportunity to complete lessons in these subjects	£2000
<b><u>Educational Sessions (Yr10-11):</u></b> Maths, English and Science catch up sessions were run. This supported students in filling gaps in knowledge, in preparation for the new term	£5000
<b><u>Rewards</u></b> Rewards given throughout summer school to highlight student achievement	£200
<b><u>Refreshments:</u></b> Refreshments provided for students during summer school	£200
<b><u>Administrative overheads:</u></b> Planning time and administrative support in setting up summer school	£666.45
<b><u>Additional Cleaning:</u></b> Due to current climate and Covid, each area used was deep cleaned every day	£390
