Dear Parent/Carer

Remote Learning During School Closure

As you will be aware, the Government has directed the closure of schools from Monday 23rd March. Given that this is a fluid situation, we will remain in contact during the closure, particularly around any information regarding when schools can re-open.

With the aim of reducing any disruption to students' learning, we will continue to provide an extensive programme of study, which we expect students to complete in full at home. Students are expected to complete a 'Learning Log' of the activities which they have been working on. This document will need to be handed into school on their return; the pro-forma accompanies this letter. All tasks, and all resources relating to these tasks, will be posted by teachers on Doddle (which is currently used for Home Learning). I emphasise that it is absolutely essential that your child completes this work each week. If not, they will almost certainly find themselves behind their peers on their return. Should such concerns arise, your child will need to remain behind after school, potentially over several weeks, in order to catch up, once we return.

The specific details for each subject, for Year 10, accompany this letter. In the event of an extended closure, this will be updated weekly. As a guideline, the number of hours which students are expected to spend on each subject area is below:

Additional information relating to the completion of these remote learning activities is below:

- All tasks and resources will be posted by teachers on Doddle. This week in school, all students have had the opportunity to check and re-set their password if necessary. If students are unable to access Doddle, please email helpdesk@goffs.herts.sch.uk
- Teachers will be available to answer queries by email. All email communication should be via the student's school email account. Again, all students have had the opportunity to check and re-set their email passwords if necessary this week. If students are unable to access their school email account, please email helpdesk@goffs.herts.sch.uk (I accept that this initial contact may inevitably be from a parental email account)





- Teachers will be available to answer queries between the hours of 8.30am and 3.00pm, from Monday to Friday. Although staff will endeavour to respond to queries as soon as possible, please do not expect an instantaneous response; staff are likely to be dealing with a number of queries. Please also note that part-time staff will not be expected to respond to queries outside of their usual working days, and that staff will not be available for student communication if they are unwell. If students do not receive a response to a query within 24 hours, they are welcome to contact the Head of Department and SLT Link for the relevant department (as listed below). - We are aware that some students do not have access to the internet at home and so a suite of work will be provided in hard copy. A member of staff will be in contact today or on Friday to arrange this
